The **Business Law Clinic** at the University of Victoria is a student-run legal clinic which provides **free legal information** to eligible clients.

Services are provided year-round except for the months of April, August, and December. Due to **COVID-19**, all client communications will take place through email, phone, and zoom conference calls.

The clinic is staffed by upper-year law students. They are not licensed to give legal opinions. Students can only provide information about business law issues as they relate to business planning and operations. All legal information is setted by lawyers.
