



Public Interest Law Participation Fund (“PILP Fund”) Tariff Rates 2025

1. Lawyers, consultants, and experts: maximum hourly rate commensurate with the current Legal Aid BC Tier 3 hourly tariff for family law services, plus reasonable disbursements.
2. Travel: use the most economical means of travel available. Travel by air is permitted only if travel by other means is unavailable or impractical in the circumstances. If the latter, outline the reason briefly and use economy fare rates. If travel is by car, the meterage rate is commensurate with the current Legal Aid BC meterage rate for actual distance travelled to a specified location.
3. Meals: commensurate with the current Legal Aid BC meal rates.
4. Accommodation: if overnight stay is required, outline briefly the reason and use the most reasonable accommodation option available. Privately owned accommodation in all areas, including that of a friend or relative, is authorized to a nightly amount commensurate with current Legal Aid BC amounts.

PILP Fund grant recipients will be expected to submit their receipts for reimbursement. The maximum amount of any PILP Fund grant will be \$10,000.
